- Lagasse Jr. and the America's Incredible Pizza Company race team crossed the finish line in the 14th position last weekend at Phoenix but were credited with 20th due to a late race penalty
- Lagasse Jr. will be making his first appearance at Homestead-Miami Speedway. The No. 11 America's Incredible Pizza Company Chevrolet will carry rookie stripes
- Lagasse Jr. will welcome some very important guests this weekend. Two passes were raffled off to help support the Children's Miracle Network
- Lagasse Jr. will be competing for Rookie of the Year honors next season in the NASCAR Nationwide Series

CJM Racing Quick Facts:

- This season marks the first time CJM Racing has competed on a full-time basis in the NASCAR ranks. They are currently 17th in the owner points with one race remaining
- Interim crew chief Mike Sibley will once again lend a hand to CJM racing this weekend. Sibley is a Camping World East crew chief from Joe Gibbs Racing that has worked with rookies Joey Logano and Marc Davis. Logano and Sibley won the championship together in 2007
- Crew chief Paul Wolfe will join CJM Racing at the end of the year and will be calling the shots atop the pit box for Lagasse Jr. in 2009
- CJM Racing will be making their 50th career start in the NASCAR Nationwide Series this weekend
- The America's Incredible Pizza Company race team visited Homestead-Miami Speedway last year where they started 21st and finished 28th
- The team is running chassis #08 at Homestead. This chassis has run at California twice (14th, 14th), Nashville twice (18th, 15th), Darlington (7th) and Lowes in the spring (17th)
